Happy New Year! The staff at Bothwell School wishes everyone a great start as we welcome you back to January 2024! I hope you enjoyed a restful holiday break with family and felt the joy of the season and that the sense of JOY stays with you all year through!

As students return to classroom routines and schedules, they will continue to have opportunities to grow and further develop skills as they take part in their learning. Planning for deeper learning opportunities includes the 6 C's of our HSD Deeper Learning: character, creativity, citizenship, critical thinking, communication, and collaboration skills. Helping students to be stronger learners is a goal as staff are working together to plan learning that aligns with our school goals:

-support students to strengthen literacy with a focus on reading and writing skills

-support students to strengthen numeracy strategies with a focus on strengthening how we work with numbers and understand problem solving

WHEN STUDENTS ARE ABSENT

If your child is going to be **absent from school for part of a day or longer**, please notify the school by:

- entering the absence on your Parent Portal or
- informing the office and/or teacher ahead of time, with a **signed note, email or phone call** or
- call the school the day of the absence **between 8:30 A.M. and 9:00 A.M.**

We will call all homes where students are absent without communication from a parent.

If you pick up your child **during** the school day, please <u>come to the office and sign out your child</u>. If someone other than your child's legal guardian is to pick them up, **PLEASE notify the school with your permission by email to** <u>bothwell@hsd.ca</u> **or phone call**.

GRADE 8 INFORMATION: TRANSITION TO GR. 9 AND JUNE FAREWELL

The Grade 8 Class will be supported with transition plans to attend Grade 9 next year. Students in our school are set to attend Grade 9 at the Steinbach Regional School in Steinbach (SRSS) as there is arranged HSD bussing for our students to attend SRSS for their highschool programming. If you plan to have your child attend a different school other than the SRSS, please let us know. Soon, we will have information from SRSS to help students with an orientation tour and course selections.

In June, our students will be involved with plans for a year end farewell celebration that will take place as a class event during part of their school day. Any parents/families that would like to plan for their own after school celebrations are welcome to do so!

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JUST A COUPLE OF SAFETY REMINDERS

For Students:

- 1) Be extra careful when crossing any street since vehicles often require a greater distance to stop on snowy/slippery streets.
- 2) Follow the Crossing Guard's instructions. Walk across safely, do not run or ride a bike across the path.

3) Dress with warm clothing, footwear and mitts since all students will be outside for AM/PM and noon hour recess as we follow the HSD weather guidelines.

For Parents:

1) Please use the visitor parking areas for pick ups and drop offs and <u>do not</u> use bus loop.

2) Please slow down and be extra careful in our school zones- 30 km speed in school zones.

STORM, COLD WEATHER AND SCHOOL CANCELATION INFORMATION

- 1) On days when school is in session, students may arrive at school at 8:50
- 2) Students should be warmly dressed for winter weather for all recess breaks.
- 3) General recess guidelines we follow:
 - a) When the temperature or wind chill is -30° C or colder, recess is indoors.
 - b) When the temperature or wind chill is between -25°C and -29 °C, recess is shortened or indoors.
- 4) When individual buses are running late or are cancelled, HSD posts the bus number and how late it is on the division website, www.hsd.ca. The division does <u>not</u> call each family on the route with notification.
- 5) If all of the schools in the division are closed due to bad weather or extreme cold, and bus service is cancelled, you will receive a phone call from the division. An announcement will also be made on AM 1250 and 96.7 FM radio stations between 6:00 AM and 8:00 AM. The cancellation notice will also be posted on the division website, www.hsd.ca.

PLEASE NOTE: No one is at the school on cancellation days. Please do not drop off students and drive away as there is no one at school to let them in to use the phone.

ONLINE REGISTRATION FOR KINDERGARTEN

Kindergarten registration for the 2024-25 school year will open on January 8, 2024. To be eligible, Children must be five years of age on or before December 31, 2024. The registration process will take place online at <u>www.HSD.ca</u>. If you do not have access to the Internet, please visit the school office and we can assist you in completing the registration on a school computer. Parents/Guardians are encouraged to register their children soon after registration opens in January. Early registration will assist us in preparation and planning for the upcoming school year. Registering before March 1, 2024, will ensure there is sufficient time for school appointments and provide parents/guardians with the opportunity to participate in Kindergarten orientation activities in May 2024. 
